Friends of the Teton River raised more than \$1.1 million in total revenue and support in FY 2020, with the majority of funds (86 percent) going to on-the-ground projects and programs, including stream restoration projects and fisheries research, water quality and soil health monitoring, the Farms & Fish Inititative, aquifer recharge, and community education efforts. Revenues were earned from individual donors and events, federal and state grants, foundation support, and fee-for-service contracts.
